
### Appendix: Network Maps

In the fall of 2013, IEI surveyed participants in each of the IEI-sponsored community forums held earlier that year about their mutual working relationships at an organizational level. The goal was to see who was already talking with whom <u>about educational alignment issues</u> both **BEFORE** and **AFTER** the community meeting. Only counties with survey response rates at 40% or above were mapped. Maps for these six counties are reproduced below showing pairwise connections, as well as the average number of connections per organization for the county.


#### **Beaufort County**


## **Cabarrus County**






#### **CUMBERLAND COUNTY**
