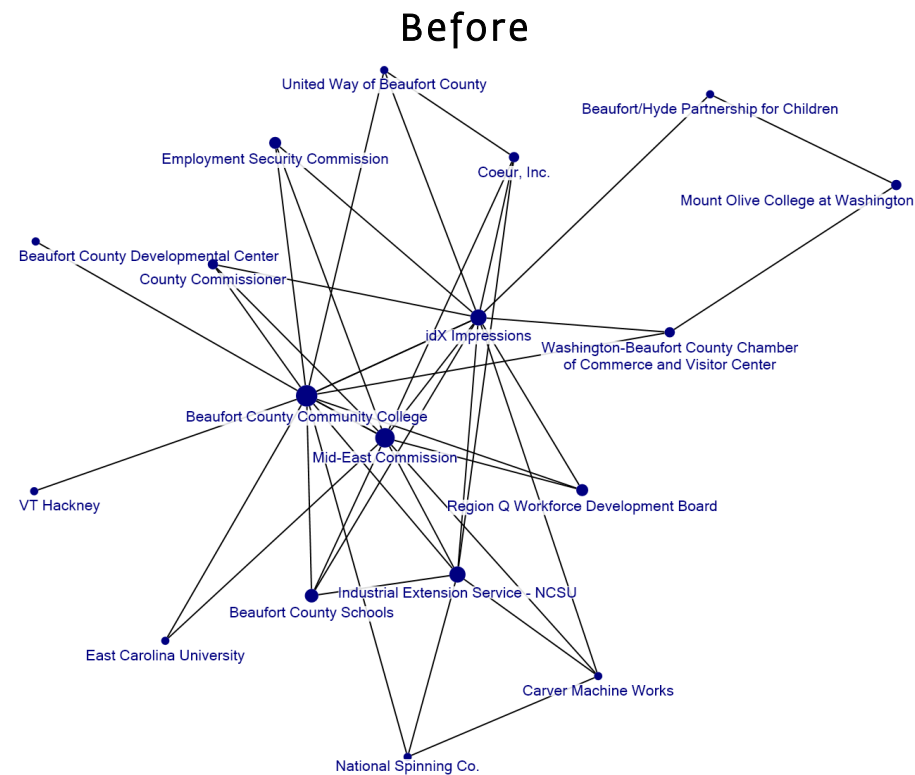


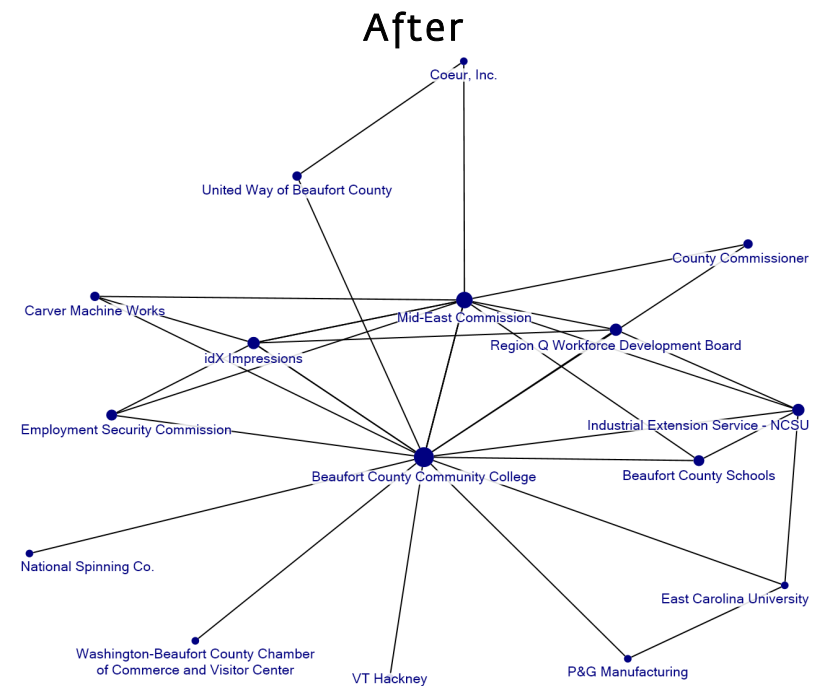
## Appendix: Network Maps

In the fall of 2013, IEI surveyed participants in each of the IEI-sponsored community forums held earlier that year about their mutual working relationships at an organizational level. The goal was to see who was already talking with whom about educational alignment issues both **BEFORE** and **AFTER** the community meeting. Only counties with survey response rates at 40% or above were mapped. Maps for these six counties are reproduced below showing pairwise connections, as well as the average number of connections per organization for the county.

### Beaufort County



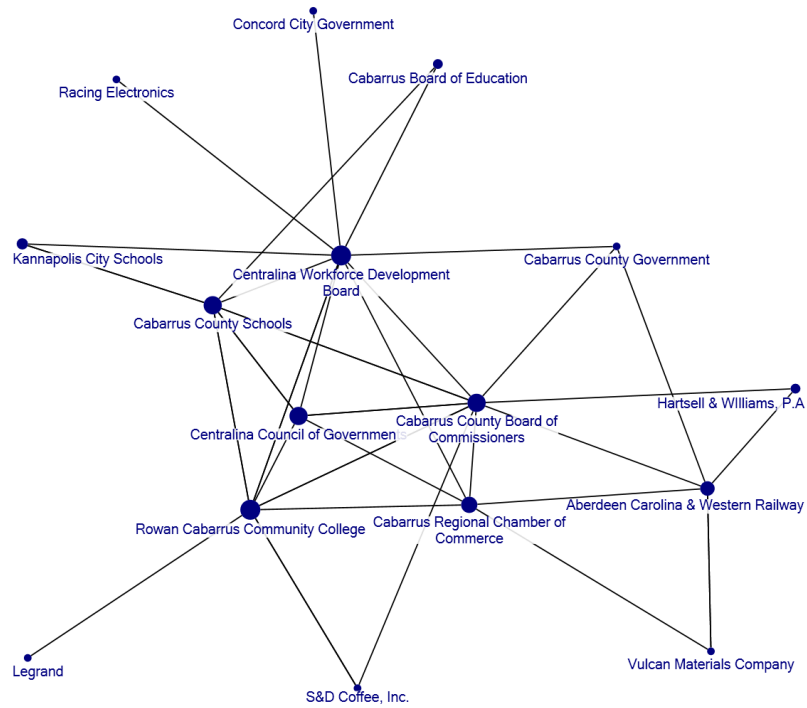

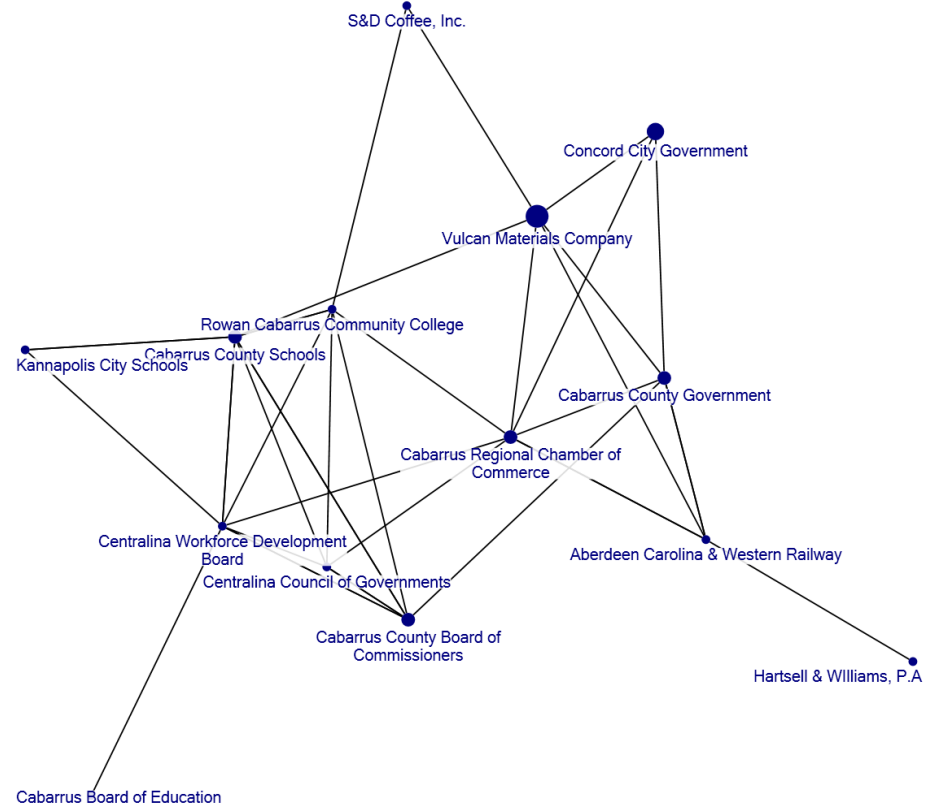

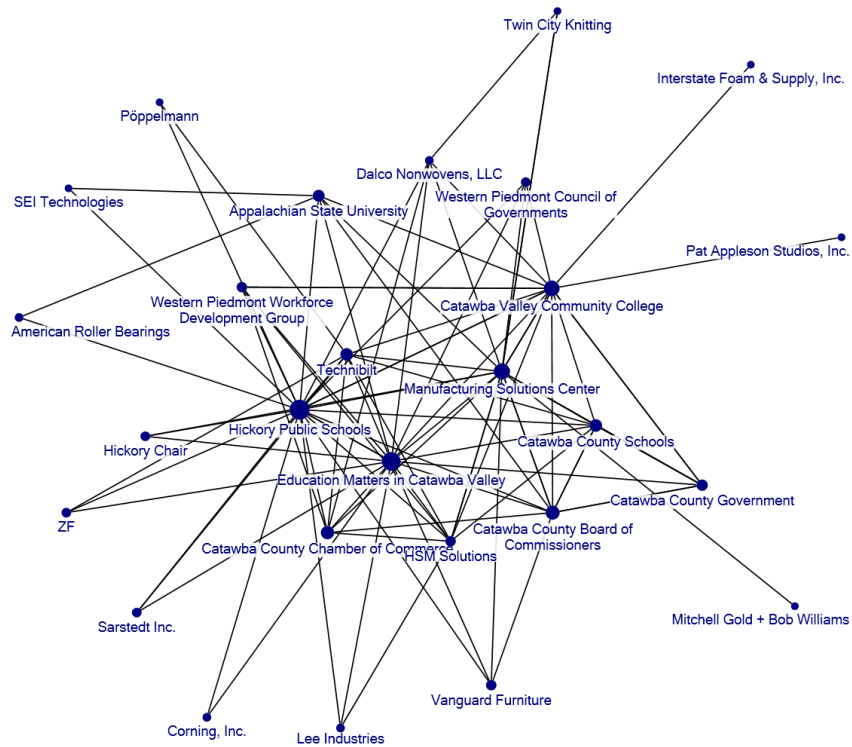

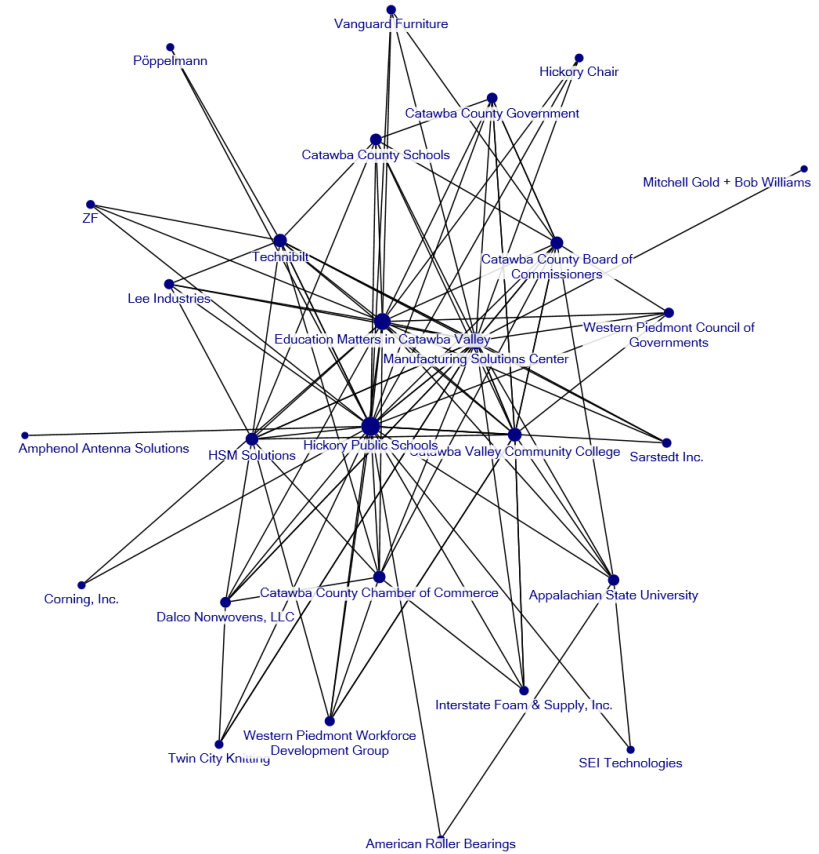
# Catawba County

Average number of connections per organization: 6.3

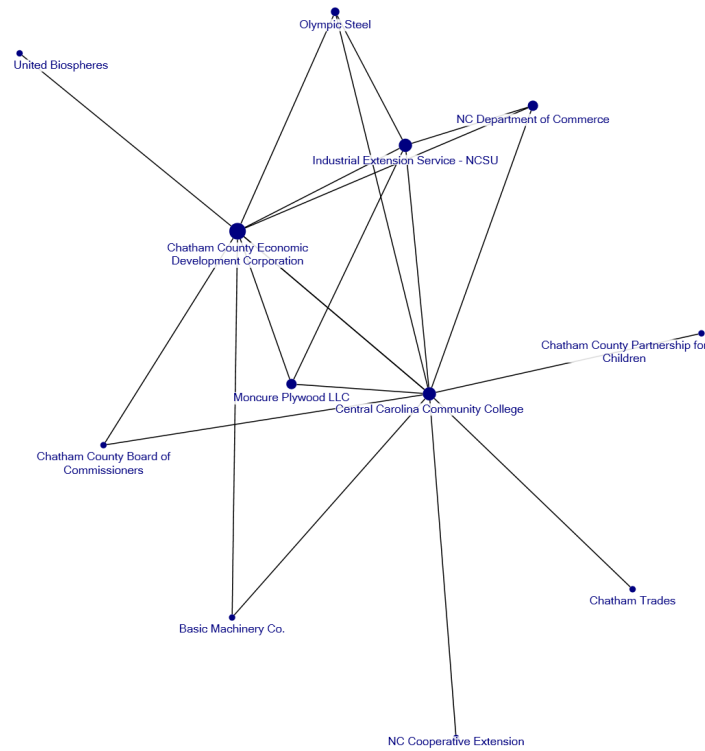

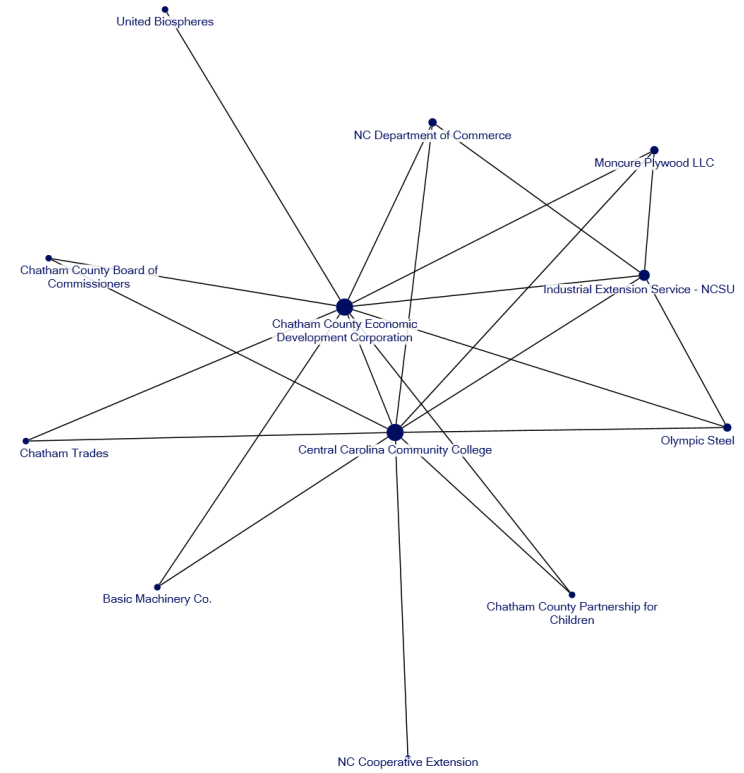

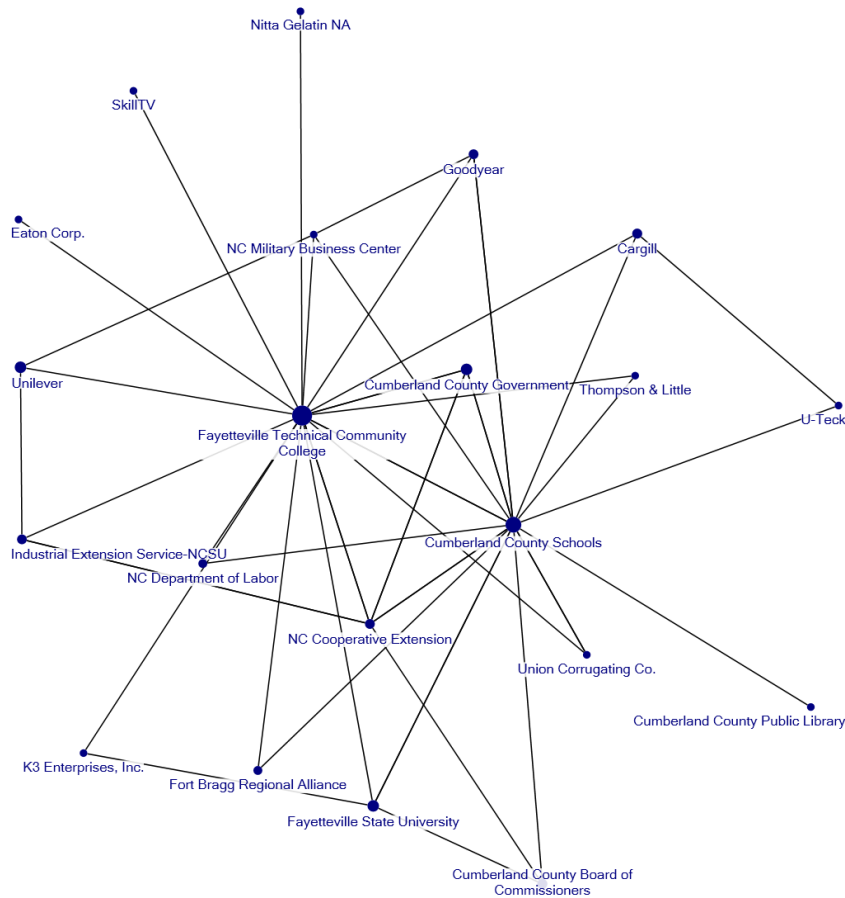

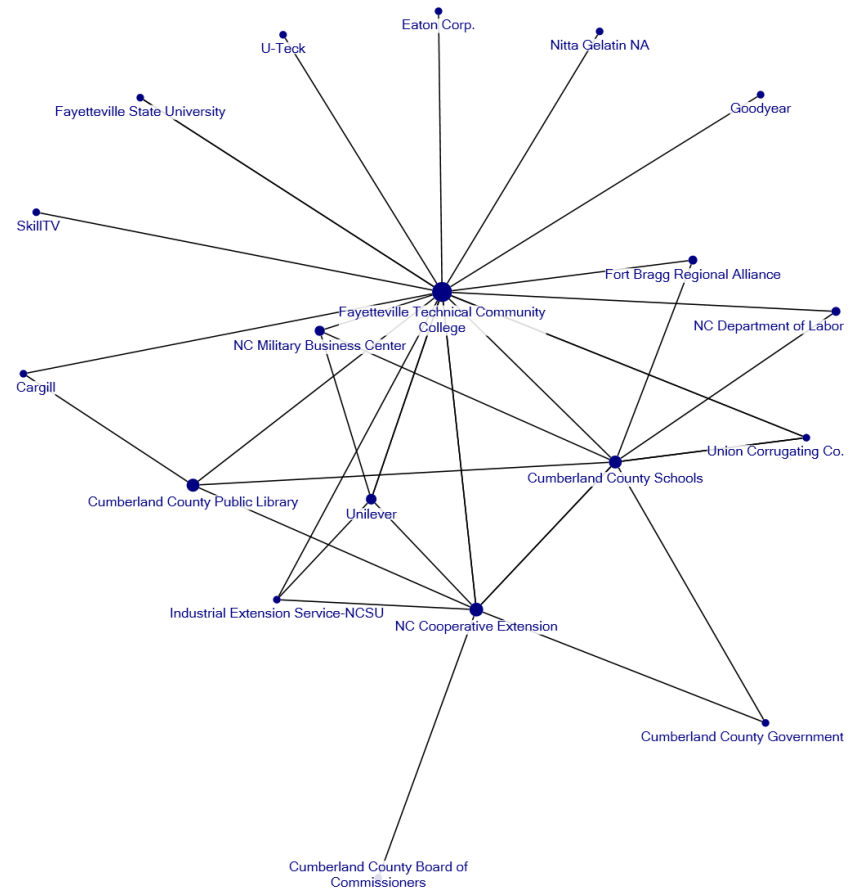

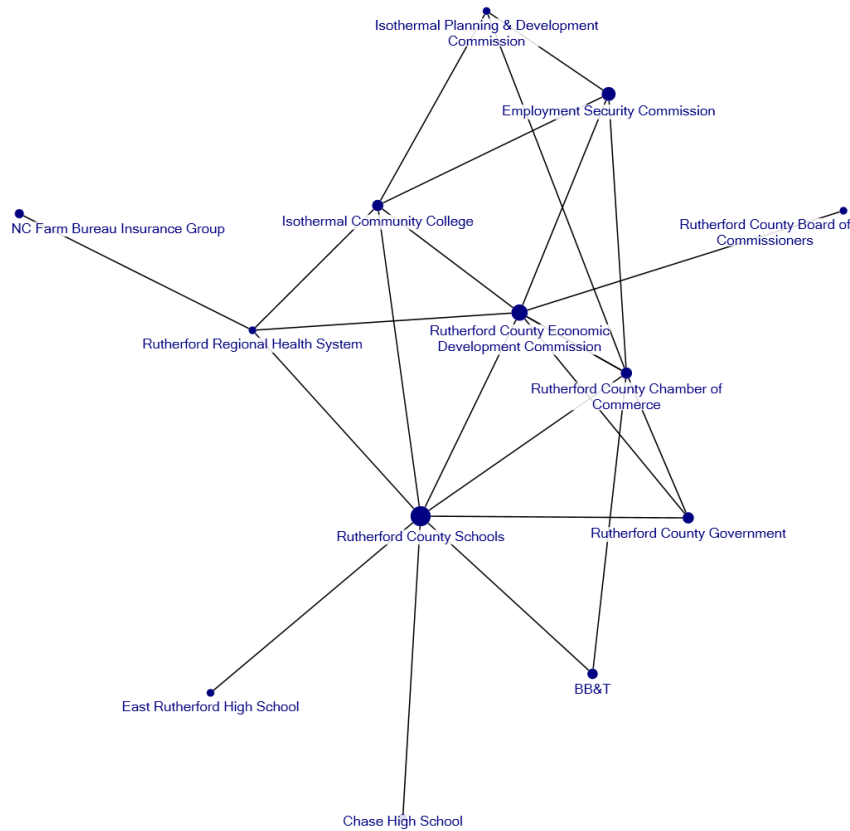

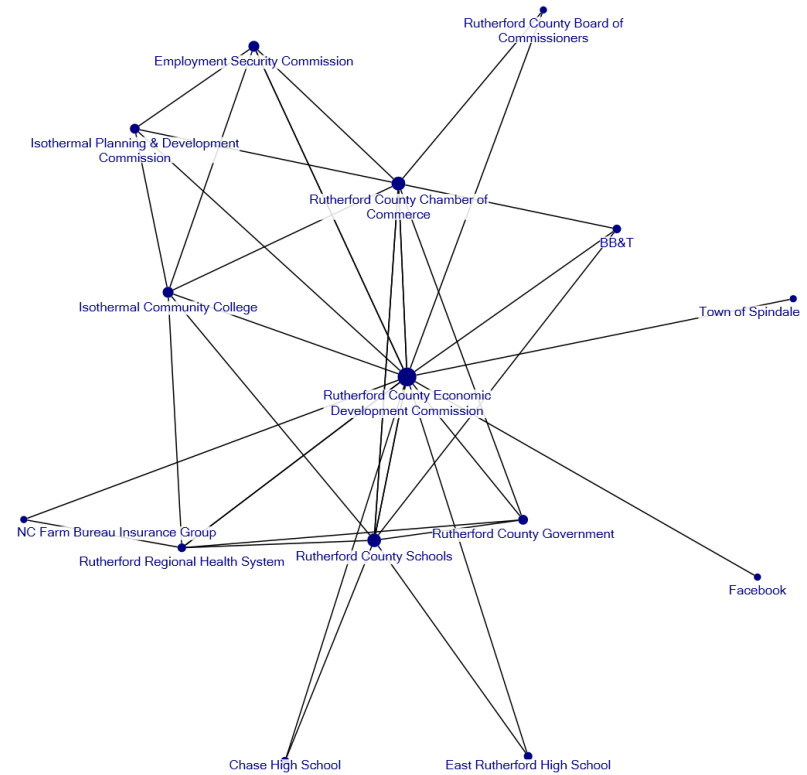
